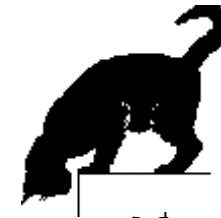

Q. What is One By One?

A. One By One is a no-kill, non-profit, cat rescue and shelter. Our all-volunteer organization is dedicated to helping abandoned, stray, injured, and unwanted felines. We find loving homes for many. Those who don't find homes are welcome to live in our shelter or in a foster home for the rest of their lives. All cats receive any necessary veterinary care.

Q. Where are you located?

A. Our cat shelter is located in a rural area near Kutztown, PA off Route 222 about 18 miles midway between Reading on the west and Allentown on the east. Shelter visits are by appointment only.

You can also adopt our cats at two adoption centers in PETsMART stores - State Hill Road in Wyomissing (next to LA Fitness) or Fifth Street Highway in Temple (next to Target).

Special weekend adoption events are held at the PETsMART adoption center locations.

Q. How do I adopt?

A. An adoption application and a home visit are required.

Q. What is your adoption fee?

A. A donation fee of \$70.00* is requested. (*Additional \$20.00 deposit for unaltered kittens)

Q. What happens if I cannot keep the cat?

A. The cat must be returned to One by One. No exceptions.

Q. May I declaw?

A. Our policy requiring that the cats keep their claws is strictly enforced, as we feel it is in the best interest of the cat not to declaw. Please see our website for a complete article on declawing. However, because some cats that are surrendered or rescued are already declawed, you may still find your forever friend without claws.

Q. May I let the cat outside?

A. No, we feel strongly that cats be kept safe and happy indoors.

Q. How can I help?

A. We are always looking for volunteers, foster parents, crafters, sponsors, shelter maintenance and of course, donations of money and food.

Q. Are my contributions tax-deductible?

A. Absolutely. We are a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.

Q. How is my donation used?

A. The donations are used directly for the health and well-being of the animals. We have no paid staff.
